Introduction

The project entitled "Integrated Project on Food Security, Disaster Risk Reduction (DRR) and Climate Change Adaptation in Jumla and Mugu Districts of West Nepal", (INFO, DRR/CCA Project) in Jumla, Mugu district of west Nepal", has been implemented with the financial support of Caritas Germany and technical support from Caritas Nepal and implementation partnership with PACE Nepal. The program started in 15 December 2019 and will end in 30 June 2023

The project activities have been implemented in six rural Municipalities and one municipality (Kanakasundari, Hima, Tila, Tatopani, Patarasi, Khatyad and Chhayanath rara Municipality) of Jumla and Mugu district, targeting 17 cooperatives and 43 community group. More than household: youth, group member, cooperative member, cooperative management team have been directly benefiting from this project through capacity building approach for sustainable

livelihood. The overall objective of the project was improved resilience of the poor and marginalized communities of Jumla and Mugu districts of Nepal. The project improved resilience of the poor and marginalized communities of Jumla and Mugu districts of Nepal. The primary beneficiaries of the project are, most vulnerable families especially those with limited capacity to cope with the current situation women headed households, Dalits, indigenous people, disabled, single women, disaster affected, and socially and economically excluded families and Victims by 10years civil war (the proposed district have been severely affected by the 10 years' of Maoist insurgency. The impact of civil war still remains with the victims and they have not been able to fully recover their losses).

There were various activities conducted such as fruits orchard management training to build capacity for cultivation, nursery establishment of seasonal and seasonal/seed plastic house off distribution for commercial vegetable farming, distribution of potato seeds for indigenous potato promotion, Mushroom production training for the promotion of mushroom cultivation for sustainable livelihood for landless

people, Agricultural Farmer Field School Ward level orientation Program for (IPM) FFS to enhance their knowledge and skills motivate them to grow crops locally and to support modern/traditional agriculture system. Training on off season vegetable Production and Seed production of major potential was conducted in order to enhance their knowledge and skills, to motivate them to grow crops locally, help in diversifying their nutrition and promote seed production. Apple sapling plantation was conducted with the aim of utilizing the marginal land and to check the landslide and soil erosion. Potato farmer field school was organized to make the participants competent by enhancing their ability to analyze and make decisions through participatory exercises based on experiential learning. Simunlation, first aid training for capacity buid in disaster prepaidness,4 palikas DPRP,LDCRP 3 palika safe construction policy. Another major activity is monthly meeting of cooperatives, Cooperative audit support & support organized annual general assembly in order to make them financially independent. The awareness program was completed on the occasion of international earthquake day, Environment day and woman day celebration.



This includes the formation of community first responders and task force members and risk watershed level assessment and DRR assessment planning. The component successfully formed Ward disaster management committees (WDMCs) and local disaster management committees (LDMCs) in all of INFO, DRR/CCA project working municipality and strengthened their capacities with Disaster risk reduction and management and access to information platforms to respond to and mitigate local shocks and stressors.
